IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES:

1. Candidates whose names appear in the merit list are required to be physically present on the day of admission.
2. Candidates must produce all relevant documents in original for verification on the day of admission.
3. **No cash payment will be accepted. Only UPI/ credit card/debit card will be accepted as mode of payment.**
4. Candidates need to fill up their details in the college management information portal on the day of admission. Payment confirmation receipt will be provided only after filling up the required information. Detailed instructions will be provided on the day of admission.
5. Candidates are not allowed to change the preferred major option on the day of admission. Merit lists will be prepared based on major subject (core 1) preference provided by the students at the time of application.
6. The **bank account details** of the candidates are required on the day of admission.
7. Candidates need to provide their **ABC Id** on the day of admission which they can generate using the following link <https://www.abc.gov.in/>

DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION:

Candidates whose name appear in the merit list must produce the following documents in original at the time of admission:

1. One hard copy of the application form.
2. Class X original marksheet
3. Class XII original marksheet
4. Caste certificate (as applicable)
5. PwD certificate (as applicable).
6. Extracurricular certificate (as applicable)

REQUIREMENTS TO AVAIL FEE WAIVER SCHEME:

1. **Fee waiver scheme is not applicable for admission in BCom course in Guwahati College.**

2. Students need to produce any one of the following documents in original as proof of domicile of Assam.

- PRC
- Voter ID Card
- AADHAR card
- BPL card
- Passport
- Birth Certificate

2. They have to submit an income certificate from competent authority stating that his/her parental income is less than Rs 2.0 lakh annually from all sources.

3. Students have to produce a geo-tagged postcard-size photograph of a sapling planted at his/her home. Students need to nurture the sapling and to avail fee waiver at the time of admission of subsequent years, students have to show another photograph of the same sapling which will be scrutinised by a committee. Only after a satisfactory recommendation from the scrutiny committee, students can take benefit of the fee waiver scheme of the government.

4. A declaration from the candidate that neither of his/her parents is an employee of State Govt/Central Govt/Semi Govt/ State or Central Govt Undertaking and they will attend classes regularly and maintain a minimum 75% attendance. [\(Click here](#) to download the declaration form)
